

Making Disciples: The Goal of the Great Commission

Discipleship is a life shared, not a program completed. It begins with a personal, growing, and vibrant walk with God through His Word and prayer that shapes the inner life (Psalm 1:1–3; John 15:4–5). Only then can true discipleship rightly flow, as we share not only the gospel of God but our very lives also (1 Tim 4:15). Biblical discipleship invites faithful believers into close fellowship, where truth is taught, character is observed, and obedience is modeled (Acts 2:42; John 13:34–35). Our commission as disciples of Jesus Christ is to make more disciples of Christ who will make more disciples of Christ (2 Timothy 2:2; Matthew 28:19–20). In this way, disciples are not merely gathered, but formed and sent, ensuring the continued multiplication of Christ-centered, obedient servants for the work of the gospel (Ephesians 4:11–13; Colossians 1:28).
