Medical Missions

Dr. Jack Mitchell, Medical Missions Coordinator

Dr. Jack frequently reminds us that medical missions trips come with many, often overwhelming, logistical challenges. The teams depend on God's faithfulness to direct them and to smooth the way (see 1 Thessalonians 5:24; Proverbs 3:5-6). Intercessory prayer is vitally important!

1. Please pray for discernment about the documentation (such as licensing) that each country requires for treating patients.
2. Pray for understanding of the requirements for bringing medicines and supplies into each country.
3. Ask God to give favor with customs officials as supplies are brought in.
4. Great travel mercies are needed with smooth, on-time flights, connections of team members, and no lost luggage.
5. Pray for unity in the teams, particularly that each person may be a blessing to others.
6. Pray for good health and stamina for the team members.
7. Most importantly, pray for effective gospel proclamation, that the Word would have free course and be powerfully proclaimed during clinic times.
8. Pray that God would use the team experience to draw the members of His choice to full-time ministry.
9. Pray for wisdom in planning the ministry component of upcoming teams.
10. Ask the Lord to open the door for a new medical mission team location that students could go to in 2026.
